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### CUBIC Partners unite in Denkendorf to drive the next phase of bio-based innovation



On October 7–8, 2025, the CUBIC partners met at DITF in Germany for the project's 5th consortium meeting. The agenda combined knowledge-sharing sessions, technical updates, and forward planning to guide the project into its next development stages.

The first day was dedicated to assessing current achievements and defining upcoming strategies, while also integrating the constructive feedback received during the first period of the project. Partners presented updates across all Work Packages, highlighting new promising formulations, validation reproducibility at intermediate scale, and certified Renewable Carbon Content (C-bio) analyses that confirmed consistency across scales.

The second day featured a **hands-on training session** organized by [DITF](#), [Carbotainer](#), and [CIDETEC](#) offering valuable insights into the development of novel bio-based and recyclable materials designed to replace conventional complex thermoplastic and thermoset products. Participants also toured DITF's **state-of-the-art research facilities** and witnessed first-hand the production of bio-based carbon fibers.



### About CUBIC

CUBIC is a Horizon Europe project, aiming to develop and demonstrate novel circular biobased alternative materials, 100% recyclable by design. These new materials will be manufactured as B2B intermediate semi-finished products that can be used either individually or assembled in the final end-user product. The overall objective of these new bioproducts is to provide an alternative biobased solution to the manufacturing industry by boosting green and digital transformation. The CUBIC consortium, led by Aitiip, consists of 13 partners from 8 European countries (ES, FR, IE, BE, DK, DE, IT, GR).
